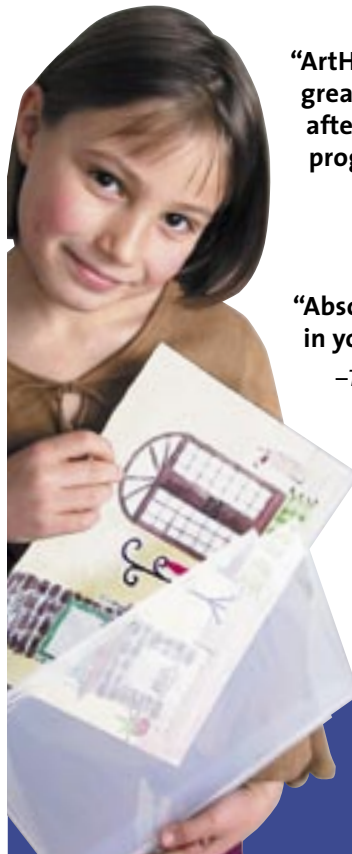

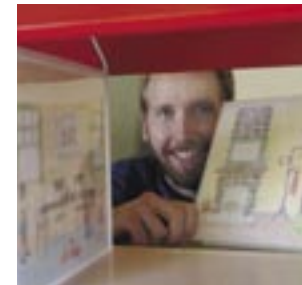

Combine images from different sources: Stack playfully-posed digital photos, magazine pictures, and internet images "scrapbook style". Use colored paper or dollhouse wallpaper to make contrasting backgrounds. Tell stories with your art!

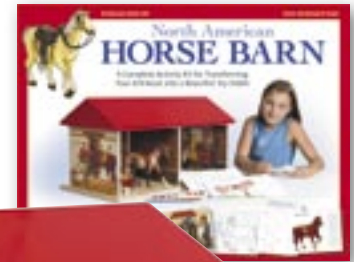
